



# SOLAR SYSTEM MOBILE



## REMINDERS

- Only a grown-up should do any cutting.

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 8 ½" x 11" cardstock (we recommend 110-pound paper for best results)
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- One-hole punch
- 11 pieces of string in varying lengths (9 to 18 inches each) – these are for the planets and ships; you choose which string goes with which piece
- 12-inch embroidery hoop
- 24 inches of string
- Screw-in metal hook



## HOW TO MAKE IT

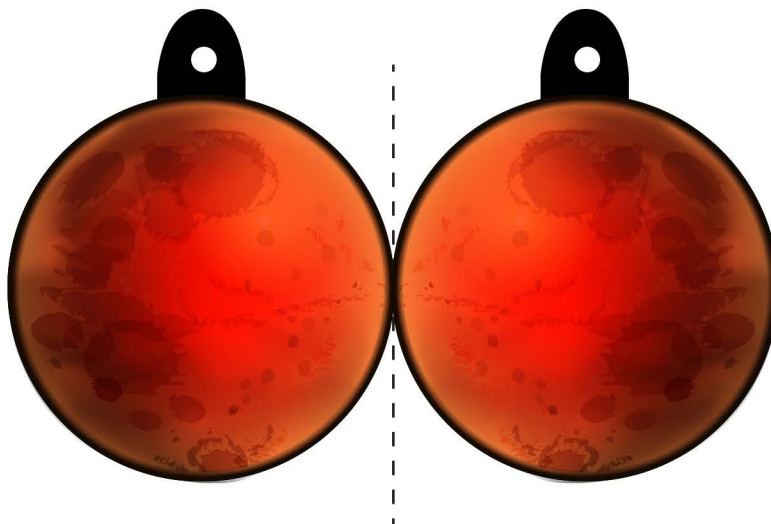
1. Print the following pages and have a grown-up cut out the pieces.
2. To assemble the planets, Stellosphere, and StarJetter, fold each piece in half along the black dashed line and glue the backsides to each other.
3. Use the one-hole punch to punch a hole through the white dot in the black tab on top of each piece. Tie a piece of string through the hole and knot it.

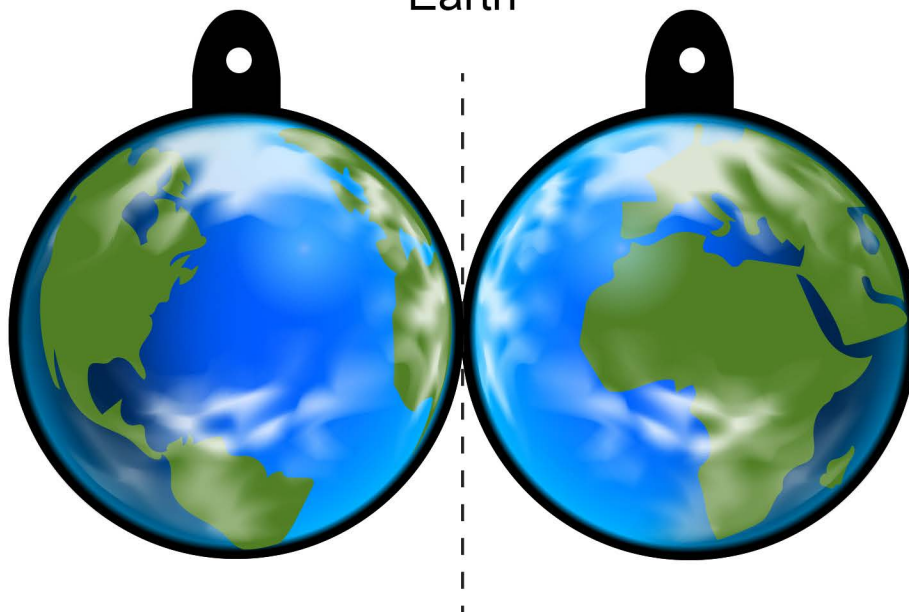
4. Tie and knot the other end of the string securely to the embroidery hoop for hanging.
5. Space out the placement of all 11 planets and ships evenly along the embroidery hoop.
6. Tie the 24-inch string on top of the hoop, making sure to knot securely at both points.
7. Have a grown-up screw in the metal hook into the ceiling. Hang the mobile off the hook.

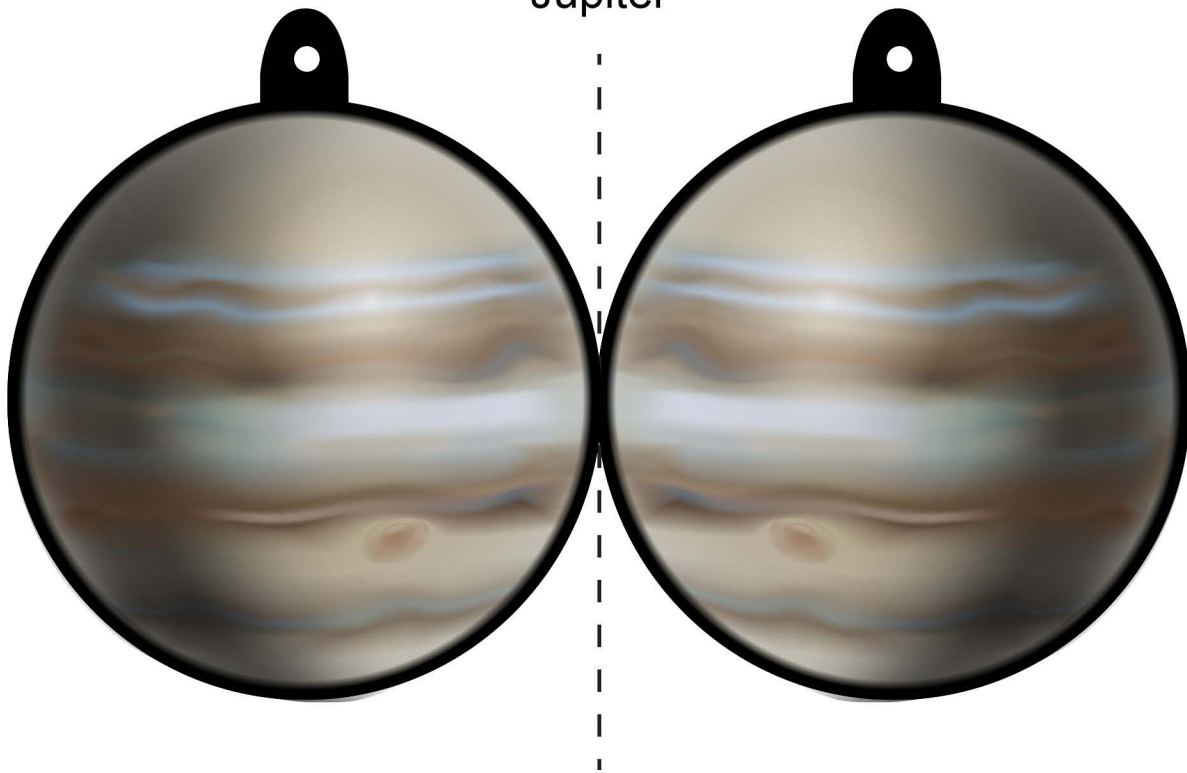

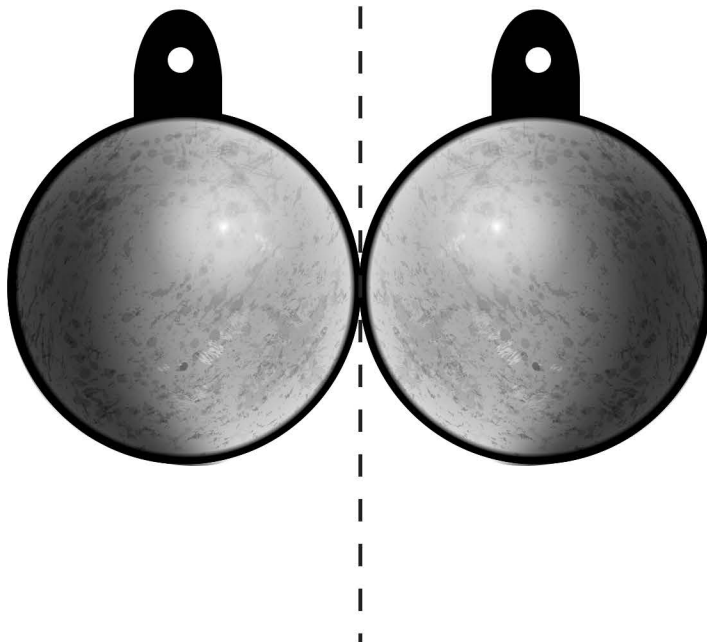

Jupiter



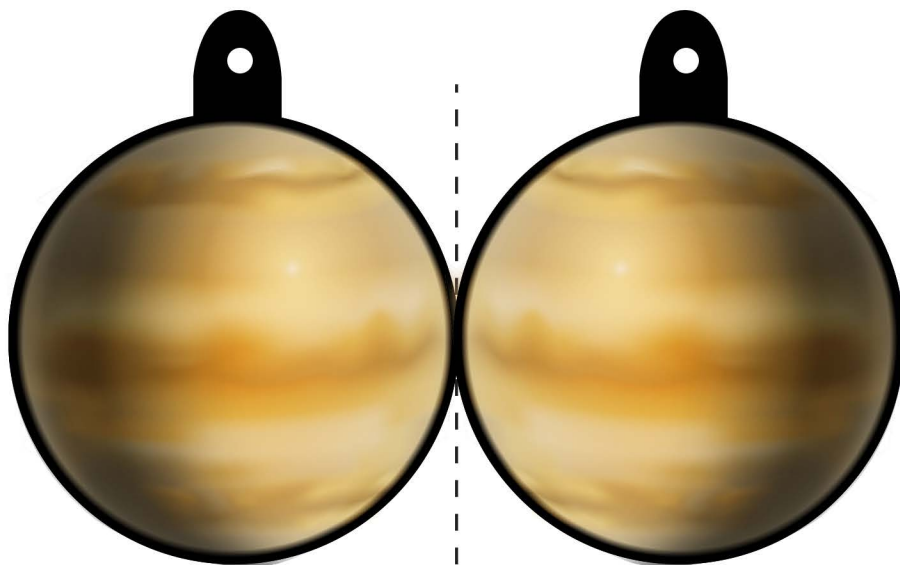

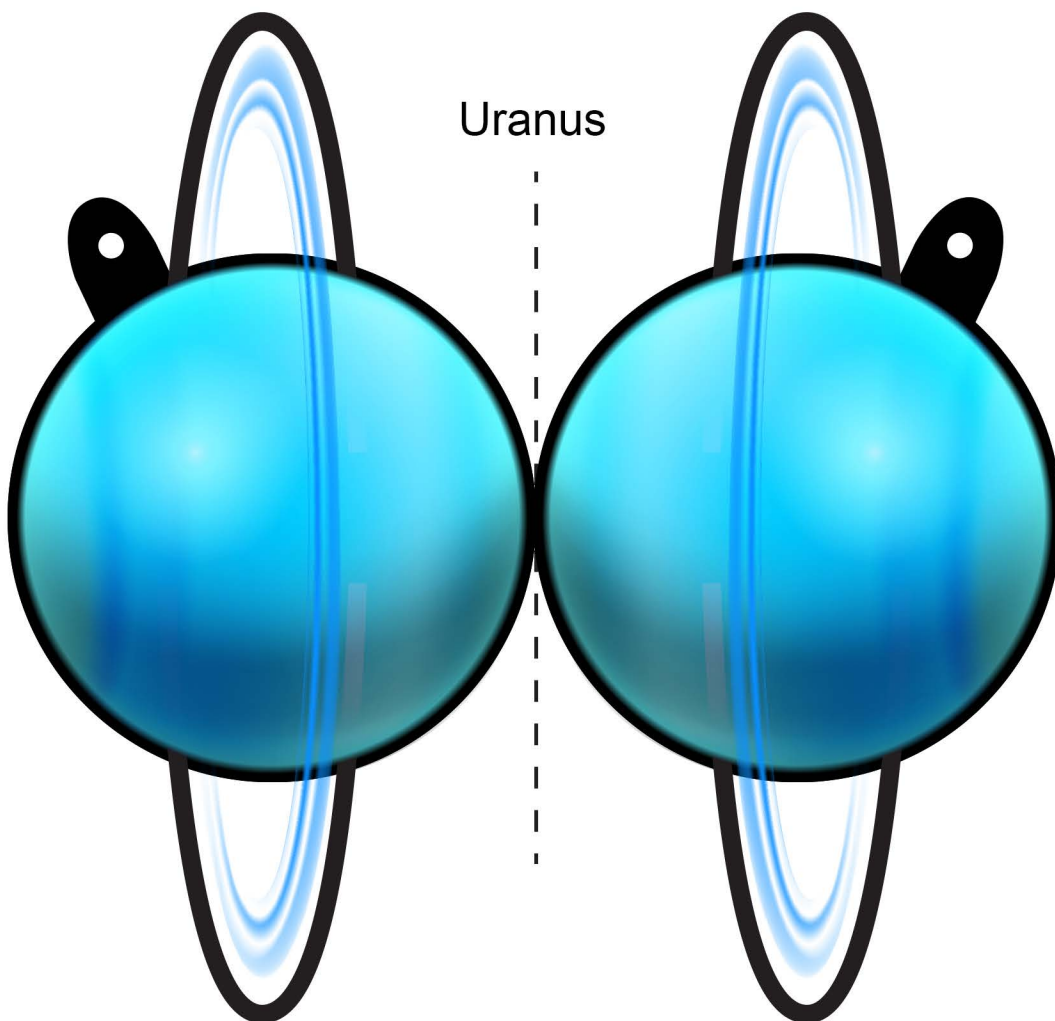

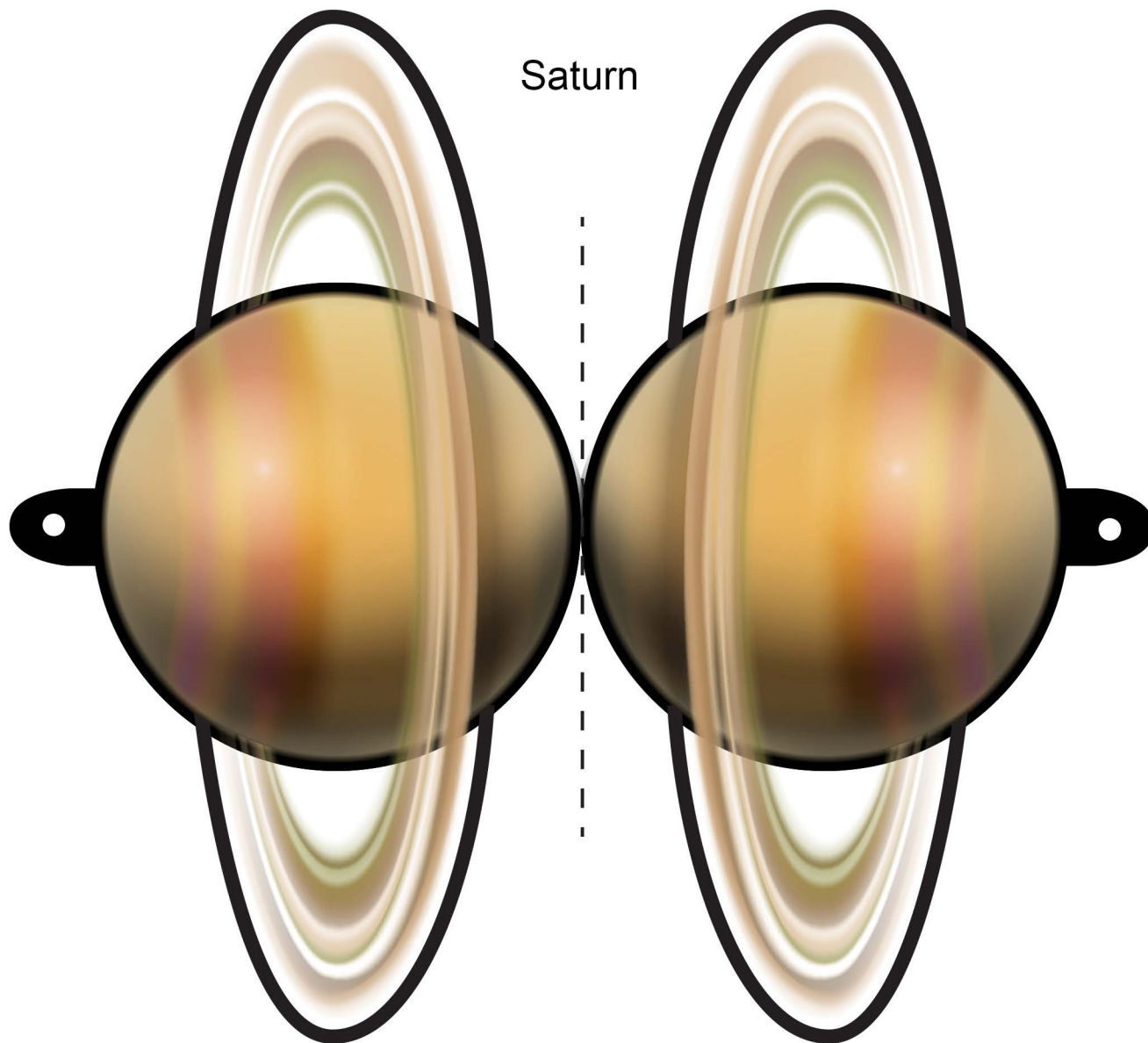


Uranus

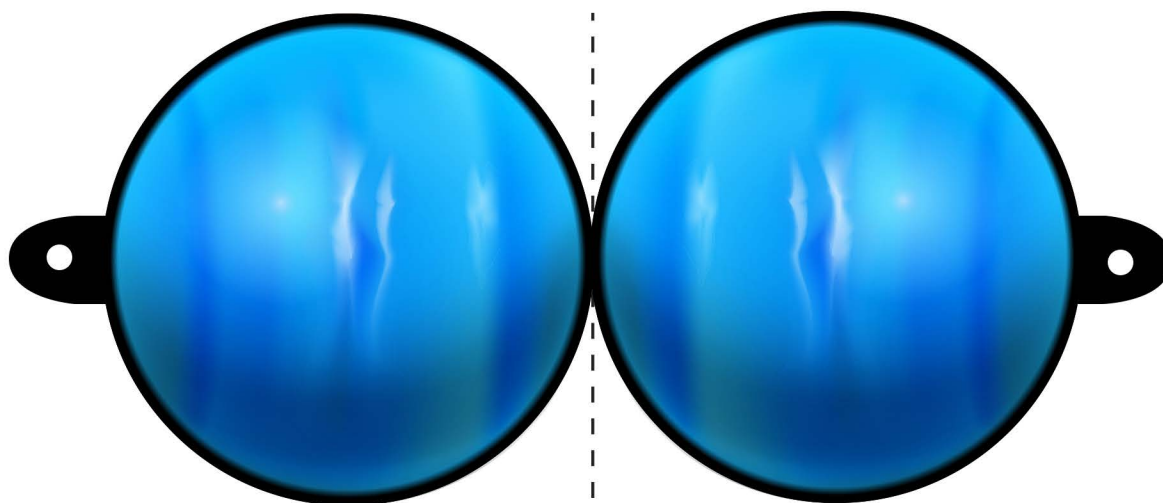

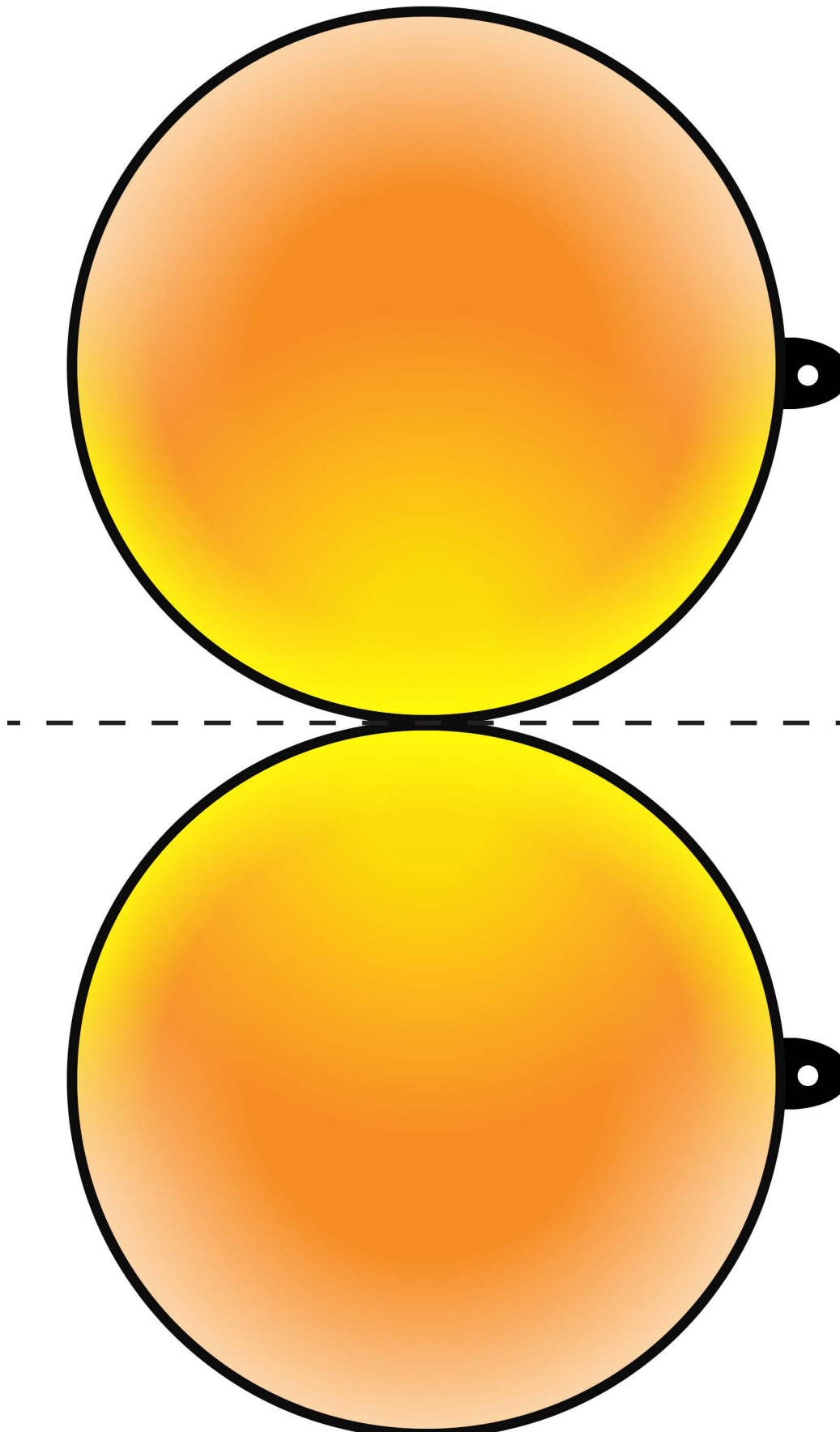


Neptune

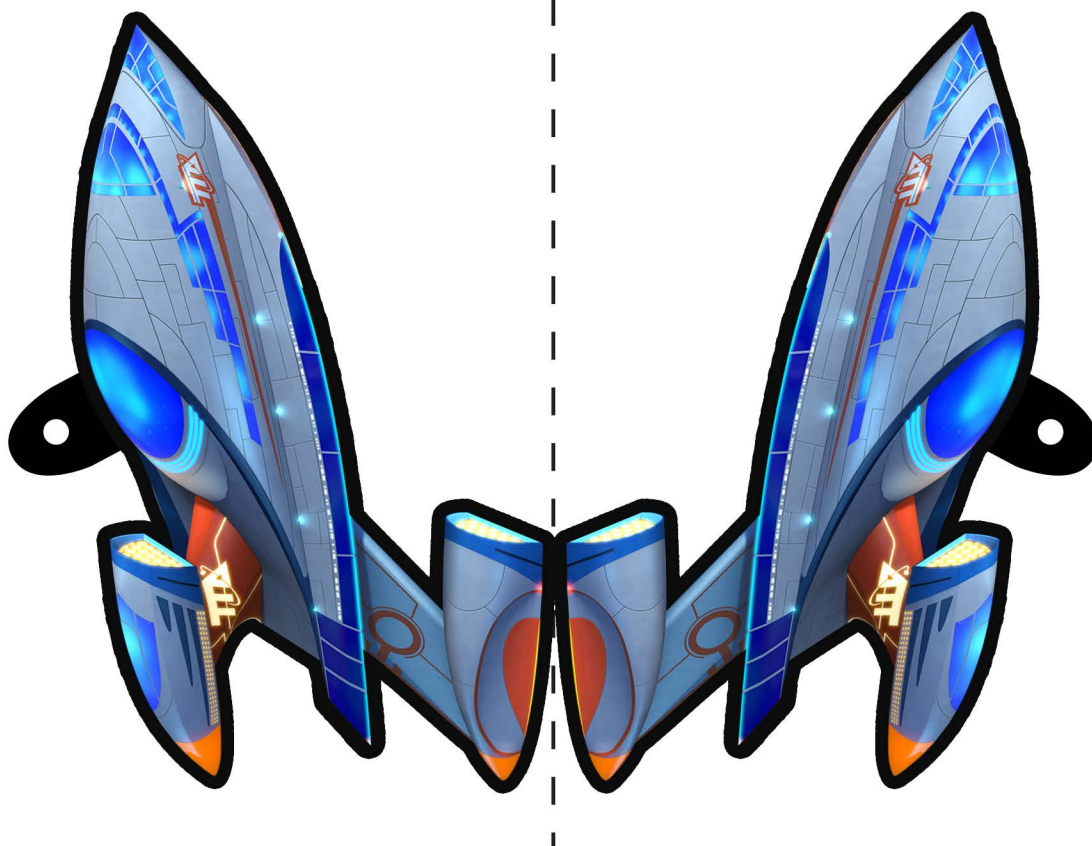
