Only a grown-up should use the scissors and cutting knife.

What You'll Need

- 8 1/2" x 11" cardstock (we recommend 110-pound paper for best results)
- Scissors
- Cutting knife
- Tape
- Glue




How To Make it

- Print the following pages and have a grown-up cut out the picture frame and frame stands.
- 2. Have a grown-up use a cutting knife to cut out the gray area in the middle of the picture frame.
- 3. Place a 4"x6" photo in the opening and tape it to the back of the picture frame.
- 4. To assemble each frame stand, glue the backsides of the yellow sections together. Fold the B tabs outward and glue them to the back of the picture frame.
- 5. Once you've assembled both frame stands, affix both to the back of the picture frame, one on each end for optimum support.
