DRAW A Robot Friend

Materials: Paper, Markers or Crayons

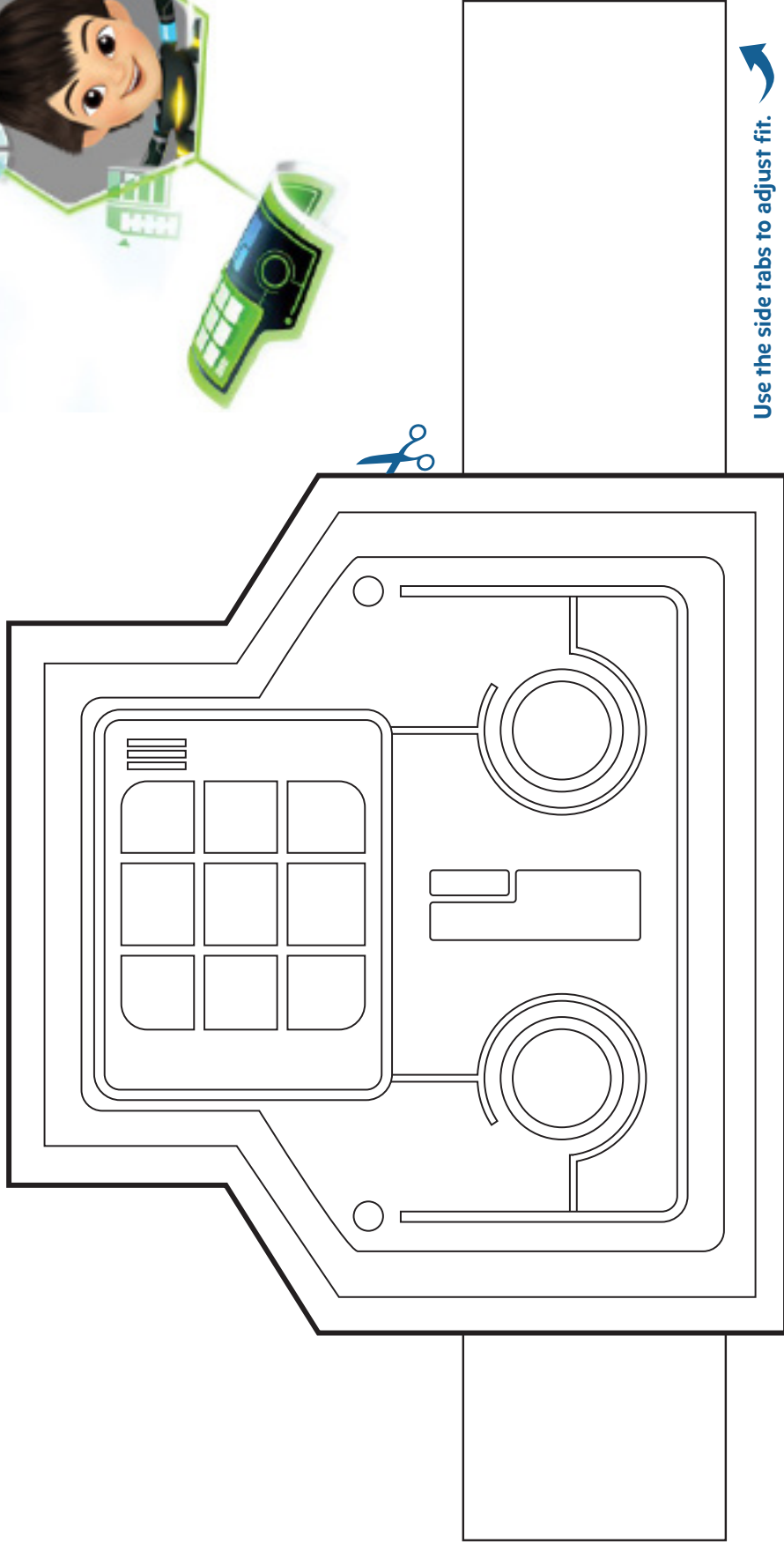

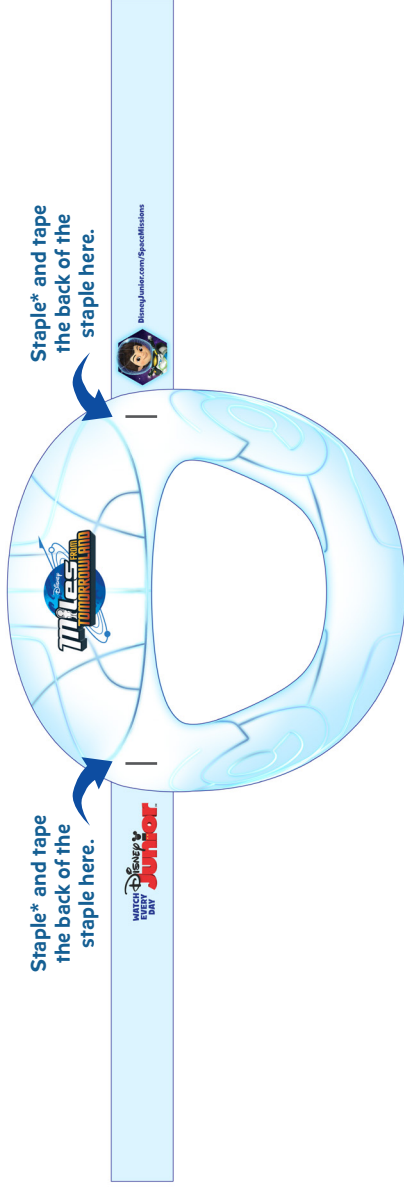


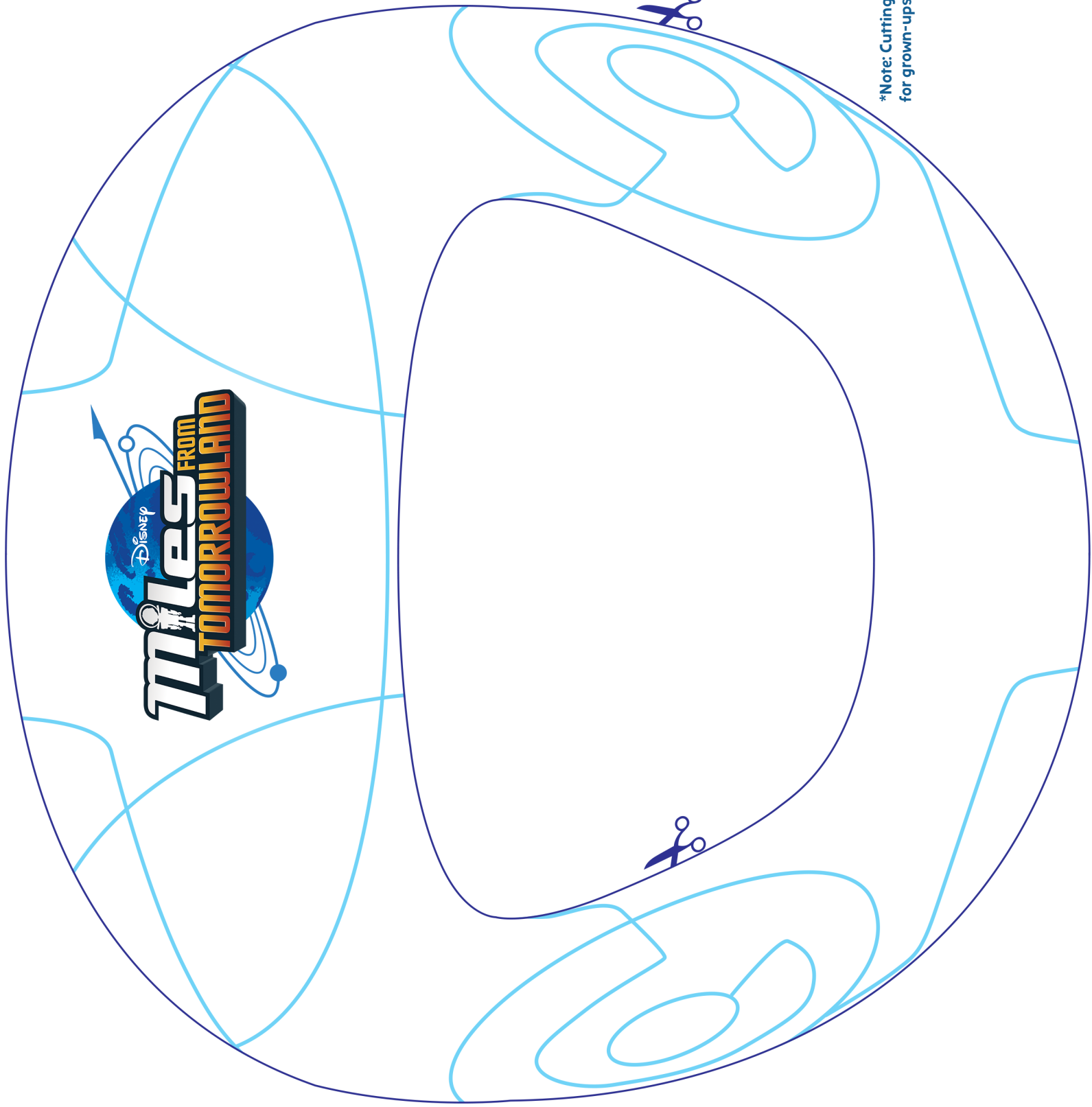
SPACE HELMET

Instructions:

1. Print both pages on heavy paper stock and color.
2. Cut* out the front of the helmet and two headband pieces.
3. Staple* each side of the headband to the helmet. Put tape on the back side of the staple to protect the child's face.
4. Adjust the headband to fit the child's head and secure with tape.

Instructions:

LASERANG



Instructions:
