



Sofia looks forward to lighting the Wassailia candle each year. Make your own Wassailia candle, a part of every family's holiday celebration in Enchancia.

Reminders

Cutting and scoring are intended for grown-ups only!

Do NOT use a real candle with this craft!
Only use a battery-operated candle.

What You'll Need

- 8 1/2" x 11" cardstock (we recommend 110-pound paper for best results)
- Scissors
- Cutting knife
- Ruler
- Glue
- Battery-operated tea light candle



How to Make It

1. Print pages onto heavy cardstock.
2. Have a grown-up cut out the pieces.
3. Have a grown-up lightly score along the dashed lines with a cutting knife. Use a ruler to ensure edges are straight.
4. Roll Candle Body into a tube shape and glue together at Tab A.
5. Roll Candle Holder into a tube shape and glue together at Tab A. Glue Circle B on top of the small tabs.
6. On Candle Top, have a grown-up cut out the gray area and fold down the small triangular tabs.





7. Flip Candle Holder over so that Circle B is the base and the opening is at the top. Glue Candle Top's triangular tabs to the inside wall of the Candle Holder opening.
8. Glue Candle Top (with attached Candle Holder) to the small tabs on the top of the Candle Body so that the Candle Holder is hidden inside. Place battery-operated tea light candle in the opening.
9. Glue Candle Base to the small tabs on the bottom of the Candle Body.

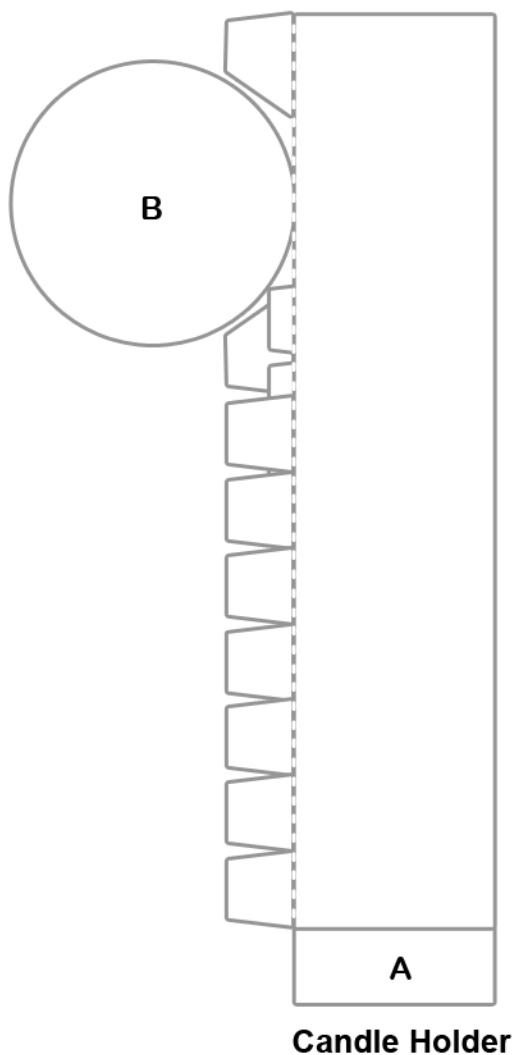

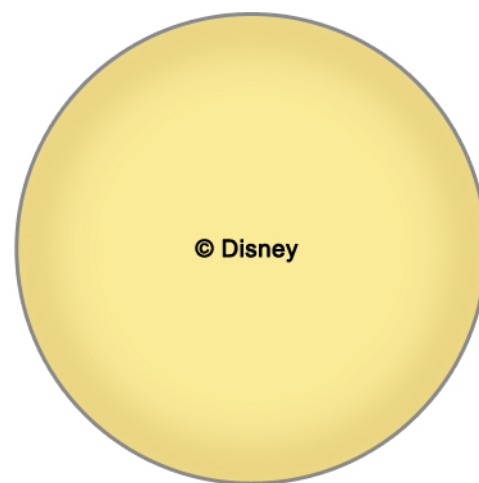
