

DISNEY COOKABOUT SHOW

Casting Terms and Conditions

PLEASE NOTE, THIS IS A CASTING FOR A PRODUCTION, AND THE CHILDREN SELECTED AT EACH STAGE SHALL BE AT DISNEY/PRODUCER'S ABSOLUTE SOLE DISCRETION. IF YOU HAVE NOT BEEN CONTACTED BY THE DATES PROVIDED BELOW, UNFORTUNATELY YOUR APPLICATION HAS NOT BEEN SUCCESSFUL.

Disney have commissioned Penguin Films to produce season 3 (18 (eighteen) episodes) of the television programme 'Disney Cookabout'. Disney Cookabout is a comedic adventure game-show that uses food preparation, cooking and outdoor exploration to showcase local ingredients and a fun-filled approach to healthy eating.

Disney is offering 8 (eight) 'Cooktestants' the opportunity to feature in 9 (nine) episodes of the Show subject to the following Casting Terms and Conditions.

For the purpose of the casting process, where we say "Rules" we mean these Casting Terms and Conditions, "Production Company"/ "Producer" means Penguin Films, "Disney" means Disney Chanel South Africa, "Parent"/ "You" means the parent/legal guardian of the child, "Child" means the child you have submitted an application for, "Personal Information" means any personally identifiable information provided to us by you relating to you or your child.

BY SUBMITTED YOUR APPLICATION, YOU AND YOUR CHILD AGREE TO THE REQUIREMENTS SET OUT IN THE PROMOTIONAL MATERIAL AND THE FOLLOWING RULES:

1. CASTING AND PRODUCTION DATES.

All dates are subject to change:

2. ELIGIBLE APPLICATIONS

For the application to be considered, the following criteria must be met:

- Parent must agree to abide by these Rules;
- Application must be submitted by either a Parent on behalf of the Child or by an Agent/ Manager on behalf of the Child with the Parent's consent;
- Parent and Child must be residents of the Gauteng province in South Africa;
- Parent and Child must be available for the duration of the Casting Sessions and Call Back Sessions;
- Parent and Child must be available for the duration of the Production Period;
- Parent/ Agent/Manager must submit a video ("Video") of the Child answering the question set in the promotional material;
- Child must be 10-13 years old on 18 April 2019.
- Parent will be responsible for travel expenses for casting and call back sessions.

3. TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION

- Access the promotional page: disneycookabout.co.za.
- Login or register your details.
- Complete the questionnaire.
- Upload a video of the Child answering the question set in the promotional material.
- Accept the permissions, website terms and conditions and these Rules.
- Only 1 (one) entry per Child accepted.
- Applications only accepted via the website.
- APPLICATIONS NOT ACCEPTED FROM: Disney/Producer's employees or family members, automated entries or programs.

4. COMPLIANT VIDEOS

The Videos will be moderated. To ensure your Video is accepted please ensure:

- Only the Child you have submitted an application for should appear in the Video
- The Child must answer the question set in the promotional material
- Content shall be respectful to others and must not include any offensive or political content;
- Video to be of broadcast quality e.g. good lighting, in focus etc. Landscape is preferable;
- Video file should be no more than 250MB in size and 1 (one) minute in duration;
- Video should be in the mp4 file format;
- Child featured should be appropriately dressed. If the child looks like they are not wearing clothes, even if they are, the video will not be accepted;
- Content should be appropriate for a Disney audience;
- No personal information; no identifiable people, locations, logos or products.

5. SELECTION PROCESS/ NOTIFICATIONS

Casting Sessions : At the end of the Application Period, Disney/Producer will review the applications and shortlist approximately 120 (one hundred and twenty) applications.

Parents will be contacted by 30 January 2019 and have 24 hours to accept the invitation and confirm by telephone that they and their child are eligible to attend.

Call Back Sessions : Parents will be notified by 06 February 2019 and have 24 hours to accept the invitation and confirm that they and their child accept the invitation to attend a Call Back Session.

Casting : Cast will be notified by 20 February 2019 and have until midnight on 22 February 2019 to accept the offer.

The children selected at each stage shall be at Disney/Producer's absolute sole discretion. If you have not been contacted, unfortunately your application has not been successful.

6. ACCEPTING AN INVITATION

If we require a response and (i) no response is received by the deadline stated or, (ii) Parent withdraws their application, Disney reserves the right to withdraw the invitation and select another Child.

7. VERIFYING THE APPLICATION

Casting Sessions : Parents will be required to attend the location with identification to verify their eligibility.

- Parent ID – National ID (original) or Passport (original) and Permanent Certificate of Residence (original)
- Child ID – Passport (original) or Birth Certificate (original or certified copy)

Call Back Sessions : Parent will be required to attend the location with the appropriate ID.

8. ATTENDING A CASTING SESSION, CALL BACK SESSION, STUDIO & LOCATION SHOOTS

Casting Sessions : Producer will confirm the location, date, time of casting by phone and email. Parent and Child will be required to remain at the location for the duration of Child's allotted time. Parent will also be required to sign a release which will include a medical declaration. Child will be required to take part in an interview and activities with other children.

Call Back Sessions : Producer will confirm the location, date and time by telephone or email. Parent will be required to attend with the Child and remain at the location for the duration of the Child's allotted time. Child will be required to take part in activities with other children.

Studio : Attendance and participation will be in accordance with the production schedule. Selected children will be required to be available for wardrobe fittings, rehearsals and recordings during the production period. Supervised travel will be arranged.

Location Shoots : Attendance and participation will be in accordance with the production schedule. Supervised travel and accommodation will be provided, and the Parent must also attend.

9. PARTICIPATING IN THE SHOW

There will be 2 sets of 9 (nine) programmes (each a "Series"). In each Series, 4 (four) Contestants shall be selected. Cooktestant will learn about food, nutrition and cooking, and in each episode 2 (two) of the Contestants will be required to participate in a series of challenges, questions and cookery exercises ("Tasks"). The winner of each Task is awarded a "Cookabout Spoon", and the overall winner of the individual episode with the most

Spoons is declared and awarded the "Cookabout Winner's Spoon". In the Series Finale the Contestants will compete to win a prize for their nominated school.

In the Series Finale all 4 (four) contestants will be set a series of Tasks and the Contestant who wins the most Cookabout spoons in this episode will be awarded the Golden Trophy and win a prize for their nominated school. The Tasks will be judged by the Presenters (in consultation with the Producer and Guest Judge), whose decisions shall be final. Where cooking Tasks are set, food will be judged on how the food tastes (2 spoons), presentation (1 spoon), technique (1 spoon), (and any other specific criteria advised by the Presenters at the setting of the Task. In the event of a tie-break, the Presenters will set a tie break question.

Producer cannot guarantee the production will be delayed in the event of illness or for any other reason why may prevent a Cooktestant fulfilling their obligations during the Production Period.

10. DISQUALIFICATION/ WITHDRAWAL OF AN INVITATION/ROLE

Application Stage: Disney reserves the right to disqualify late, misdirected, incomplete, corrupted, lost, illegible or invalid applications and applications with videos which do not meet the moderation guidelines.

Casting, Call Backs, Production Period:

- Disney reserves the right to modify, suspend, cancel or terminate the application and casting process or extend or resume the application/casting period or disqualify any applicant at any time without giving advance notice and will do so if it cannot be guaranteed that the application or casting process can be carried out fairly or correctly for technical, legal or other reasons or if Disney/Producer suspects that any person has been manipulating the application/casting process, or has provided false information or has acted unethically in any other way.
- Disney reserves the right at our absolute discretion to refuse entry or remove anyone from the location and withdraw the invitation where Parent/Child: (a) is found taking pictures/recording the event; (b) posting content regarding the show and/or their child's participation in the show on social media (c) consume or appear to be under the influence of alcohol/ illegal substances; (d) exhibit inappropriate/ abusive behaviour or attempt to disrupt filming; (e) refuse to follow instructions given by Disney/ Producer or Child become unwell immediately prior to or during the Production Period and Disney/Producer feels the Child should not proceed () breach any other rules set out in this document or any contractual obligations that may be a condition of the Parent/Child's participation in the show.
- Whilst at the location, Parent/Child must observe all rules and regulations in place (including security protocols and health and safety), and follow any instructions given by Disney/ Producer.
- Parent/ Child must not distract other cast members while on set.
- All recordings including photography is strictly prohibited unless agreed in advance by Disney/Producer.
- Locations may on occasion have to conduct security searches to ensure your safety. By attending the location, you agree to comply with any security requirements in force.
- Smoking (including e-cigarettes) is prohibited.

11. PERSONAL DATA

By submitting your application:

- You understand you are providing your information to Disney.
- You understand your personal information will be used in accordance with Disney's current published Privacy Policy and will be passed to the Producer to carry out the casting process, produce the show, create promotional material in connection with the show, and to enable Disney to promote the show in any media including without limitation Disney TV, online and publishing channels and on Disney Facebook pages.
- You acknowledge and consent to Producer contacting you in connect with administering the casting process.
- You acknowledge and consent to Personal Information in respect of your application and the casting process being held and processed by Disney and accessed by the Producer for the purposes of producing and/or exploiting the Programme and your Video in accordance laws and regulations relating to the processing of Personal Data and privacy (including but not limited to with the UK Data Protection Act 1998 (as amended from time to time) and the General Data Protection Regulation (2016/679)) and expressly consent, acknowledge and agree that your Personal Information will be passed to and used by The Walt Disney Company Africa (PTY) Ltd, and its subsidiary and group companies and, where relevant, their employees, agents and advisers, in the UK, US and worldwide for their legitimate interests for purposes connected with show, including without limitation, to publicise and fully exploit the Programme throughout the world in all media and by all means, maintain and improve security systems, safety and ensuring compliance with legal and regulatory obligations.

12. PUBLICITY

Cooktestants will be required to participate in the filming of behind-the-scenes and other promotional material for the show as briefed by Producer. You understand and consent to Disney/Producer using your Child's name, age and city in the show and promotional material.

13. CONFIDENTIALITY

Parent and Child will be required to observe the Embargo Period. Parent and Child hereby undertake that they will not publish in any media, nor give to any person for publication in any media, any interview or make or release any statement, photographs or other material relating to Disney/Producer or the Production without Producer's prior written approval. For the avoidance of doubt this includes social media including without limitation Facebook, Twitter and Instagram.

14. DISNEY'S LIABILITY

Online Application: Disney cannot guarantee continuous, uninterrupted or secure access to its website and is not responsible for any disruption to the application process due to technical problems or otherwise due to events outside of its reasonable control.

15. EMAIL SAFETY

In the event that Producer wishes to contact you in connection with your application, we will first do so via an email ending in 'penguinfilms.co.za' then follow up with a phone call. Any email which appears to come from the Producer/Disney but using a different ending (e.g. hotmail.com, yahoo.com etc) should be treated with suspicion and deleted. DO NOT respond or act on any email if you are not sure that it comes from the Producer.
